GreenRoots has several needs:

Program Outcomes Assistance. Looking for an individual or a team that can help evaluate health program outcomes using Sales Force.

Program Development. Opportunity for a TPC member with Clinical Social Work experience to provide consulting to GreenRoots' Health Equity Corps initiative. This model connects Chelsea residents to available resources as well as documents the health needs and gaps among community members. Organizers are looking for ways to develop the program further.

Employment/Personnel Review. In the process of reviewing personnel policies, GreenRoots is looking for a lawyer or volunteer with expertise in this area to provide some consulting.

RIA has opportunities ranging from:

Business Development Assistance. Looking for help in establishing a social enterprise that will provide employment opportunities to women survivors. RIA has been working toward this for the past two years but have encountered roadblocks. They are requesting help with a feasibility study.

Social Media & Design Assistance. Desire to deepen outreach through social media (FB, Twitter, Instagram) to bring in new supporters and spread the word about RIA's mission.

Project Citizenship needs connections to community leaders.

Executive Director Mitra Shavarini is looking for introductions to relevant community leaders, such as CEOs of hospitals, labor leaders, or philanthropy leaders, who may be interested in partnering with Project Citizenship. She would provide an opportunity for these leaders to offer citizenship application support to their non-citizen and immigrant employees or affiliates.
